Program Overview:

Long-term care providers continue to face new challenges as they strive to deliver optimal healthcare in comfortable, safe environments while dealing with declining reimbursement. The growing crime of elder abuse and meeting the needs of an increasingly diverse population will require providers to examine their organizational priorities to ensure they include resources to address these two important issues. This workshop will include updates regarding regulatory issues that impact reimbursement as well as an in-depth look at elder abuse, the culture, concerns and needs of LGBT older adults and the impact of these issues on long-term care in Pennsylvania.

- Describe the various types of elder abuse.
- Recognize misconceptions that often prevent incidents of abuse from being investigated and prosecuted.
- Discuss the culture, needs and concerns of aging LGBT adults.
- Recognize why LGBT older adults are less likely to access health and social services and potential ways to address the issue.
- Explain how the ombudsman and protective programs are designed in Pennsylvania.
- Identify the mandatory reporters under the Older Adult Protective Services laws providing long-term care to individuals.
